Where Are We Now?

- 5 full-day in person instruction
- Sports, clubs, and extra-curriculars
- Strong mitigation strategies continue
 - Students 6 feet apart when possible, no less than 3 apart
 - Mandatory mask
 - Saliva surveillance screening
 - Quarantine requirements for out-of-state/out-of-country travel

Summer School

- 36 courses running with 283 students currently enrolled
 - ELA, Math, Early Childhood & Enrichment
- Strong mitigation strategies to continue
 - Social distancing in classrooms (3 - 6 feet)
 - Masks
 - Saliva surveillance screening

Fall 2021-What Do We Think Now?

- Planning for full-day instruction 5 days a week
- Exploring remote learning options
- Mitigation strategies in accordance with health department guidelines.
