# Next Steps

- Deep dive into the MAP reading and math data to identify curriculum strands that were relative weaknesses and develop plans to address these in 2021/22. We will update the board on our findings.
- Summer school offered to all interested learners for the 2020/21 session.
- Offer all level courses in Middle School inclusive of advanced and workshop classes to better address student learning needs.
- Increase implementation of differentiated instructional strategies to address growth issues.
- Expand implementation of our Professional Learning Communities (PLC) inclusive of support staff and interventionists to improve instruction and better address the needs of individual learners.
- Review how we provide services to at-risk students to see if realignment of staff, resources, time, or increase in personnel are necessary
- Implementation of K-8 ELA resource including PD and ongoing coaching for ELA staff
- Learning walks with principals and staff followed by coaching sessions for participants.
