## Introduction

## Responsibilities and Communications

Coach/Supervisor Responsibilities

- Thorough knowledge of the activity to adequately prepare members for their competitions or performances
- Written information regarding team/activity rules and consequences
- Written practice and game/performance information
- Adherence to established practice and game/performance schedules
- Supervision of participants at all times
- Respect for the integrity and judgment of game officials
- Respect for the integrity and personality of the individual participants
- Knowledge of locations and times of all practices and game/performances
- Communication regarding any discipline issues that result in the denial of a student's participation
- Communication regarding concerns about students' roles as team/activity members


## Participant Responsibilities

- Adhere to school rules at all times
- Care for and return all uniforms, equipment, and supplies
- Accept and understand the responsibility and privilege of representing school and family
- Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials
- Understand rules and consequences as established by the coach/supervisor


## Parent Responsibilities

- Read, support, and follow rules and consequences as established by the coach/supervisor
- Arrange to have prompt transportation for your child in regard to practices/games/meets/performances
- Care for and return all uniforms and equipment, if applicable
- Notify coaches/supervisors of any schedule conflict well in advance
- Communicate any concerns directly to the coach/supervisor
- Refrain from discussions regarding playing time, team strategy, play calling, or other student athletes


## Spectator Conduct

- It is a privilege, not a right, to observe games/meets/performances
- Spectators are present to support the program and its participants and to enjoy the skill and competition/performance
- Spectators are expected to understand that the school's activities are a learning experience for students and that mistakes are sometimes made
- Show respect for the opposing players, coaches, and spectators
- Respect the integrity and judgment of the game officials
- Refrain from any type of profanity, obscene language, or improper actions
