JOB TITLE: Math Paraprofessional
JOB GOAL: Assist Classroom Teacher in the implementation of the district's math program for all students.
REPORTS TO: School Principal
QUALIFICATIONS: Paraprofessional license or 60 hours of college credit required (meets Illinois State Board of Education requirements for Paraprofessional).
Read, understand and follow verbal and written directions.
Utilize applicable technology to support performance responsibilities.
Demonstrate extensive knowledge of middle school math.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

General

1. Communicate and collaborate effectively with others.
2. Ensure confidentiality of sensitive information.
3. Maintain a record of dependability as evidenced by consistent attendance, punctuality and attention to work.
4. Understand and adapt to a variety of situations
5. Maintain and exhibit general and personal safety practices.
6. Maintain stakeholder satisfaction.
7. Work independently and exercise good judgment.
8. Assume personal responsibility for professional performance and growth.
9. Utilize effective problem solving processes.
10. Exhibit professionalism in appearance and demeanor.

Specific

1. Serves as a professional role model, with guidance from the classroom teacher, through interactions with students, staff members, and parents; support of teaching practices; planning, and involvement in professional development activities.
2. Implements supplemental and supportive instructional strategies to selected students as designated by and under the supervision of the classroom teacher.
3. Assists the math teacher in developing, organizing, and preparing instructional materials.
4. Provides one-to-one or small group math supervision and support to students as assigned.
5. Assists in maintaining a clean, safe, and organized environment for all students.
6. Maintains an awareness of each student's individuality and responds in a manner conveying dignity and respect.
7. Supervise students before and after school.
8. Completes other duties as assigned by the classroom teacher/supervisor to promote the overall math program.

This job description does not state or imply that these are the only duties to be performed by the employee occupying this position. An employee in this position will be required to follow any other instructions and to perform any other duties assigned by the supervisor.

EVALUATION:

Performance in this position will be evaluated annually in accordance with the provisions of the applicable policies of the district.
