Highlands Kindergarten Registration for Entering Kindergarten Students 2020-2021

LaGrange Highlands Elementary School registration for all kindergarten students will be held on Tuesday, March 3 at Highlands Elementary School from 4:00 - 6:00 pm in the Learning Resource Center. Please enter through Door 8 on Laurel Avenue or Door 1 on Plainfield Road. To establish a more efficient process, parents of students with a last name beginning A-M are encouraged to register between 4:00 - 5:00 pm, and parents of students with a last name beginning N-Z are encouraged to register between 5:00 - 6:00 pm, though we are able to accommodate anyone at any time.

To enter kindergarten in the fall, a child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2019.

To register, parents must bring the following:

- (1) a recent photo of their child, formal or informal;
- (2) an original, notarized birth certificate from the state, county, or city for verification of the child's birth date.
- (3) three proofs of residency, including one from Category A and two from Category B below.

The registration process should take between 15 and 25 minutes and is entirely online. No fees will be collected at this time. Children need not be in attendance, as there are no activities planned for them at this event.

Later this spring, registered parents will receive an additional information about <u>finalizing</u> the registration process online including lunch, yearbook, and supply kit ordering, etc.

Registered parents will also be invited to attend a parent informational meeting in early May (date TBD), from 6:30 – 7:30 pm at Highlands Elementary School in the Learning Resource Center. At this meeting, important aspects of the kindergarten program, procedures, and requirements will be discussed. Parents will hear directly from the principal and kindergarten teachers.
