What is the date for a return to a full-day of learning?

March 15, 2021

What does the school day look like on March 15?

8:20-3:15 for both ES and MS (Student drop off is 8:10 - 8:20 a.m. with 8:25a.m. is the late bell.)

How does the schedule affect Early Childhood Education (ECE)?

The school day for our early childhood education program will also adjust to the pre-Covid hours listed below:

AM: 8:30 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

PM: 12:00 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.

What will lunch look like for both schools?

Lunch will be approximately forty minutes long at both the ES and MS. Twenty minutes for lunch and twenty minutes for recess.

Elementary School

Lunch will be held in the MPR and Elementary School Gym. One-half of a grade will have lunch (class-specific), while the other half has recess. The two halves will rotate at the midpoint of their lunch period. Lunch times are as follows:

2nd Grade: 10:30 - 11:10

1st Grade: 11:10 - 11:50

Kindergarten: 11:50 - 12:30

3rd & 4th Grades: 12:40 - 1:20

Middle School

Lunch will be held in the cafeteria.. One-half of a grade will have lunch (class-specific), while the other half has recess. The two halves will rotate at the midpoint of their lunch period. The lunch times for the MS are:

8th Grade: 10:08 - 10:50

5th Grade: 10:52 - 11:35

7th Grade 11:36 - 12:18

6th Grade 12:20 - 1:02

Will a hot/cold lunch be available?

Quest Food Services will be back in operation at both schools to provide student lunches for those families who wish to participate. Lunch menus will be available the week of March 8.

Can students leave for lunch?

Students may go home for lunch. If students go home for lunch, they must sign out in the school office before leaving and sign back in upon their return. We ask that parents notify the office by 9:30 a.m. if their child(ren) will be going home for lunch. Due to scheduling constraints, lunch periods between grades and schools may not align.

Will Remote Learning continue?

Remote learning will continue to be an option for families that choose to do so.

Will students have Special Subject Classes and Physical Education?

Yes. Students will attend these classes with their cohorts. Students will travel to the special subject/physical education teachers' classrooms when possible.

What extracurricular or after school activities will be available?

Some opportunities will be available and specific plans will be sent out by each school the week of March 8.
