

## **Big Sur Update**



Thank you for helping the Tech Department update your machine to Big Sur.

- 1. Big Sur requires about **50GB** of disk space to be free (**35GB** if you already have the application Install macOS Big Sur in your Application folder). If you need to free up some disk space, there is an application on your computer called **Free Disk Space** that can help you (search for it in Spotlight). If you have problems freeing up enough space, contact the Help Desk.
- 2. Please make sure the laptop has at least **70% battery power** or is plugged into a power outlet. Leave the laptop in a safe place with the lid open after you start the below process.
- 3. Run the application "Install D106 Big Sur"
  - a. You can find this by searching in Spotlight or by looking in your Applications folder in the Finder.
  - b. If you do not have this application, please contact the Technology Department.
- 4. The laptop will restart after about 15 minutes. You can continue to use your laptop during this time period.
- 5. After the restart, it will take another 45 minutes to install macOS Big Sur. During this time, you will be unable to use your laptop.
- 6. You may need to reinstall the Canon Follow-Me printer after the update. You can do so by going to the district website -> School Life -> Printer Maps while you are inside one of the district buildings. (If you have problems, run "Fix My Computer" and try again.)
