

**LaGrange Highlands School District 106**  
**Report of IMRF Compensation Exceeding \$150,000**  
**July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024**

In 2012, the Illinois General Assembly passed Public Act 097-0609. This act amended the school code by adding section 120/7.3 as summarized below:

Each school district must post on their website the "total compensation package" for employees who receive a compensation package that exceeds \$150,000 per year. A "total compensation package" is defined as the employee's salary, health insurance, housing allowance, vehicle allowance, clothing allowance, bonuses, loans, vacation days granted, and sick days granted. This information is required to be posted within 6 business days after an employer participating in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund approves their budget.

\*The acronym "FTE" stands for "Full-Time Equivalent" and is used to communicate the full- or part-time status of an employee. In this case, a 1.0 FTE indicates a full-time, 12-month employee.
